

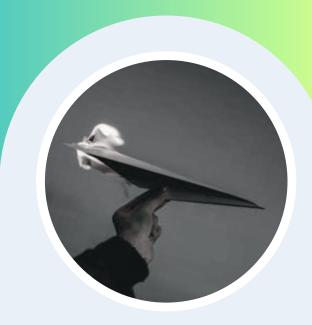
# UX EMERGENCY RESCUE

# **SUMMARY**

# **3-PHASE STRUCTURE**

# **PHASE 1 - DIAGNOSE**

A fast, comprehensive assessment.

- Stakeholder reset conversations
- Rapid UX audit (flows, usability, friction)
- Content and experience review
- Scope + timeline analysis
- Requirements + expectations review
- Team/process analysis
- Risk + dependency mapping

Output: Critical Issues Report and Risk Map.

# PHASE 2 - STABILIZE

Resolve confusion, reduce risk, and restore alignment.

- Re-align on goals, scope, and expectations
- Clarify decision authority
- Triage UX issues
- Set communication and workflow cadence
- Provide immediate UX direction to unblock teams
- Rebuild client confidence (if applicable)

Output: Stabilization Plan + Immediate Priorities + Alignment Summary.

# **PHASE 3 - RECOVER**

Deliver the actionable plan forward.

- 90-day roadmap
- Quick wins (next 1–2 weeks)
- Core initiatives (6–12 weeks)
- Team + process recommendations
- UX + product milestones
- Backup plan and pivot plan

Output: Recovery Roadmap and Leadership Presentation.

Assess situation, identify risks and determine engagement length and kickoff.
